

The challenge of decarbonization

This call for projects supports ambitious and realistic initiatives to significantly reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in Belgium by radically transforming production, consumption or organizational methods.

It is open to concrete projects or applied research close to implementation, focusing on resource management, production, transport, consumption, recycling, waste or organizational models. Projects may propose direct solutions to reduce emissions or innovations to facilitate decarbonization.



ELIGIBLE COSTS

The total budget of the support requested must be between €2 million (minimum) and €3 million (maximum).

REQUIRMENTS

- Territory: the reduction in GHS must take place on Belgian territory.
- Relevance and impact: significant, verifiable and measurable reduction in GHG emissions.
- Additionality: Additional impact compared to "business as usual" in the sector or activity concerned, contributing to Belgium's European Fit for 55 and net zero by 2050 trajectories and to legal and judicial requirements in Belgium.
- Direct reduction: direct reduction in emissions excluding projects aimed purely at carbon capture.
- « Do no harm » : no significant negative impact on biodiversity, the water cycle, soil, health, etc.
- Financial feasibility: the project must show strong potential to be financially viable.
